

# RBI Governor List of India

The Reserve Bank of India was established on 1 April, 1935 as per the provision of the Reserve Bank of India Act 1934. RBI has 27 regional offices and 4 sub-offices. It has four training establishments namely, RBI Academy, College of Agricultural Banking, Reserve Bank of India Staff College, Institute for Development and Research in Banking Technology (IDRBT). The main functions of RBI is

1. Formulates, implements and monitors the monetary policy.
2. Regulate and supervise the financial system.
3. Manages the foreign exchange and external trade market in India.
4. Issues, exchanges and destroys currency notes as well as puts into circulation coins minted by Government of India.
5. Performs a wide range of promotional functions to support national objectives.
6. Regulator and supervisor of payment and settlement systems
7. Maintains banking accounts of all scheduled banks.

The RBI Governor and Deputy Governor list is given below.

Shri Shaktikanta Das is the governor of RBI from December 12, 2018 to present, Shri M.K. Jain, Dr. M.D. Patra, Shri M. Rajeshwar Rao, and Shri T. Rabi Sankar are the deputy governor of Reverse Bank of India.
